

DEFINITION OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

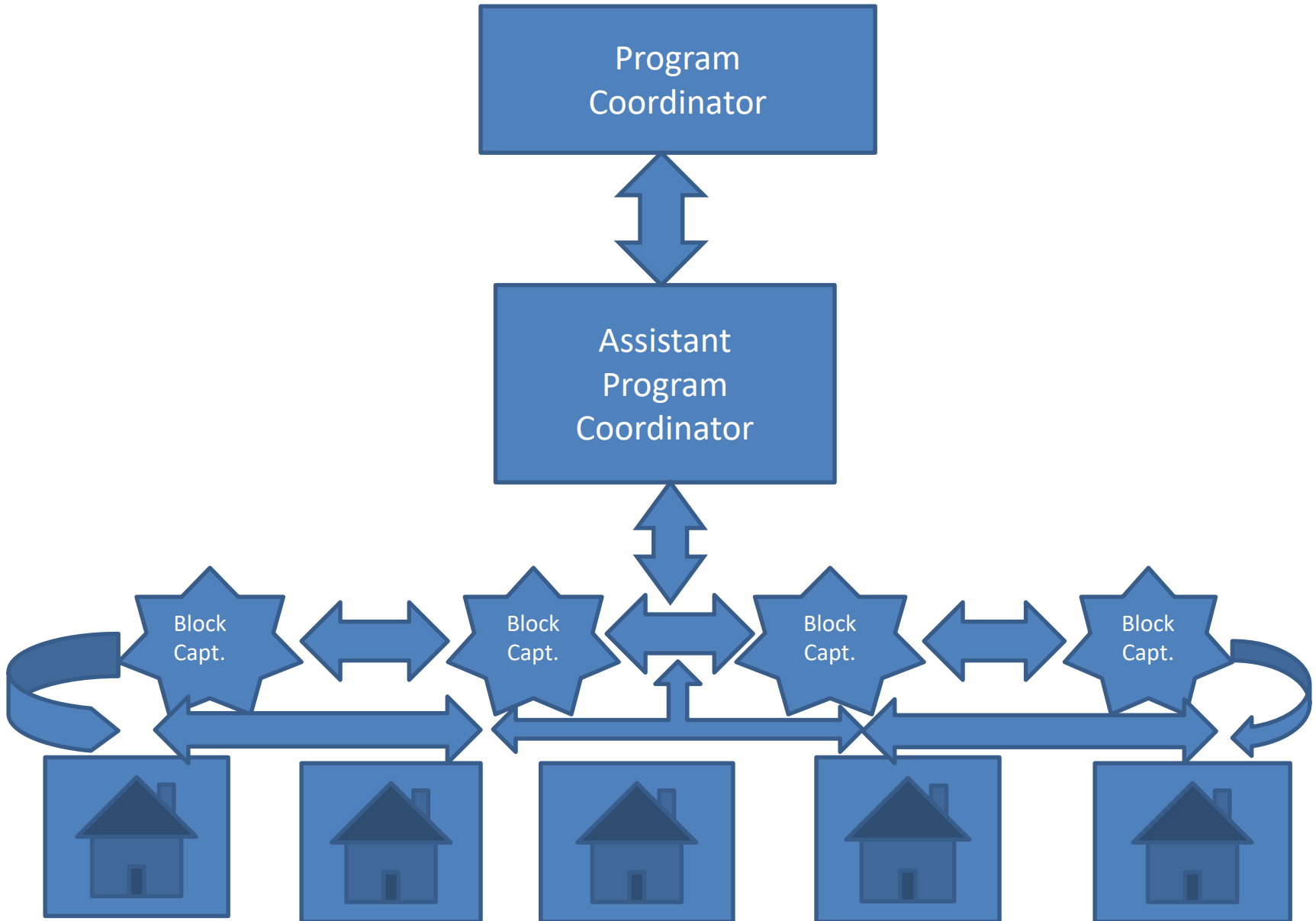
